In the framework this project will develop a device (hardware) and cloud application dedicated to the food industry. The project will address specific aspects of the logistics transportation chain that affect the live monitoring capabilities of sensitive commodities.


This innovative product will provide via user-friendly application and with support of innovative technologies in order to securely detect, exchange and store the values of the security specifications for susceptible loads. Designing consumable detection devices, and machine learning algorithms, thereby allowing the entry of new specialized products large volume data management, and IoT device security in cold supply chain management.

The project aim is to create an innovative end-to-end service for food industry with the use advantage of computer edge and machine learning that will:

- Improve the visibility and quality of services in the logistics chain.
- Assist the audit trail of fault for insurance claims through improved transparency.
- Minimize unnecessary mileage and resources for the transportation of spoiled commodities.

The project is supported by a grant from Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway through the EEA Grants Greece 2014-2021, in the frame of Greece - Business Innovation.
